Public Service Booth Policy:

- A maximum of two booths at the market are designated as Public Service Booths. These booths must be reserved in advance by submitting this application and receiving confirmation of approval by the Snellville Farmers' Market Committee. These booths are to be used only for the distribution of information to the public. Sales are not permitted at the Public Service Booths. Campaigning and the solicitation of market customers for the purpose of signing petitions are not permitted.
- Applications are considered in the order of filing, however the following criteria shall apply:
 1. Applications with critical information deadlines shall be given priority.
 2. Applications by parties where the issue is of great public concern or interest shall be given priority.
 3. Applications by public entities, such as the City of Snellville and its affiliated organizations shall be given priority.
- Groups seeking to distribute information of a religious or political nature shall not be considered and invited to use the City Hall Free Speech Area set aside for that purpose.
- Local businesses that have not been approved as paid vendors by the Snellville Farmers' Market Committee and wish to distribute information may not do so in the market area. They are invited to use the City Hall Free Speech Area.
